Pickering Creek Audubon Center has received a generous grant from Wild Birds Unlimited, the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, as well as charitable donations from community members to provide scholarships for students in need to attend this year's EcoCamp.

If you are granted a scholarship, you are responsible for a non-refundable deposit. The deposit must be paid to reserve your camper's spot.

A camper may only receive one scholarship each summer. Scholarships are granted on a first-come, first-served basis and based on need, space availability, and completeness of the application process.
